- A. Welcome and Introduction to Meeting (Bergen) 12:00-12:05. Meeting called to order at 12:08 pm
- B. Ongoing Matters 12:05-1:20
  - 1. Approval of June 2021 Board Minutes (Knoebel)

    Moved Chuck B, second John K approved unanimously
  - 2. Financials Committee Report (Lucado)

End of fiscal year June 2021. July doesn't show much because it is only one month in the fiscal year. Cash situation is incredible. 224,000 cash position at the end of the year. Due in a large part due to unrestricted donations from Mickey Hammerman. SACL book keeping firm brought Moss Adams accounting firm which added a number of changes in how things are being booked. HCC is compliant with IRS demands. Our books are kept on a cash basis. Revenue gets recognized when we book the caash. We have noticed in May and June that this accounting method will treat multi-year memberships as liability because it front ends these multi-year memberships instead of amortizing them over the number of years for 5 or 10 year memberships. Concreete example is we have to recognize the we have to provide programs for an additional 4 or 9 years.

- 3. Membership Committee Report (Trotter, Halas, Zeng)
- May through August seems to traditionally be about 300 renewals. May and June ran at about 100 renews each. July and August are lean, we have another communication going out in August. Suggestion to do exit interviews if someone drops off. Suggestion to Poll potential members in what they are looking from the HCC. Next quarterly meeting around end of September.
- 4. Marketing/Communications Committee Report (Ribaudo, Minkoff)

Working on the various platforms. Trial with membership on slack and circle. Revamping web site which is long overdue. Spring we presented web site vision. Significant updates and brand consistency. Used Squarespace. Really exciting new look to site. Very simple for committee chair to make changes and add content to the site. Very comprehensive in the function and content of the site. We will reach out to see with which other clubs we can help or collaborate. Working on communication platforms for connecting members.

5. Schools Committee Report (Palmer)

Thank you for all of the Summer Sendoff 2025 picnic. Felt wonderful to be able to get together. Likely HCC will do remote interviewing again, we should expect that it will be for the whole interviewing season. No interview fests. Pushed back a bit, but Harvard seems to be concerned with liability of in-person. Especially with virtual for another year, we are recruiting heavily for interviewers. We just missed being able to offer an interview to every student. Demand is extraordinary because no test scores are required. Really need more interviewers and more interviews by existing interviewers. Karen Grasowski retired this year and Leslie Racklin will be taking over the admin duties.

6. Programs Committee Report (Schaumberger, Koh, Daniliuc, Yoon, Mendez,)

## 7. Community Service

Cook County Department of Corrections (Hochstadt)

- Alternative programming and education pilot with 13 tutors and 40 inmates. Invited to expand to in person and vitual. This fall second session will launch the week of Sept 13 for 10 weeks. 10 women and 10 males. Twice a week and a little more intensive. Could still use additional tutors.
- Committee on Internships (Acevedo, Schwartz)
   Had a workshop for a number of industries. Doing some follow up to see if students took advantage of the oopportunities. Looking at how we can add value during J term. Continuing to build it up as an organic offering that is sustainable.

## 8. Early College Awareness (Barreno-Paschall)

Reinvigorating the early college awareness targeting 8<sup>th</sup> and 7<sup>th</sup> graders. This fall we would like to have a program with a speaker who might be first generation college.

## 9. Club Administration (Bergen)

Trying to find pace(s) to get together in person for board meetings. Ravinia event should be fun. Every year the president does a retrospective report. Our membership reports are good, community service involvement (who may not be a member of the club), trying to figure out a metric for how many people do we engage that are not necessarily members. Please think about these metrics.
