- Financial Committee Report (Lucado)

Financials are accurate. Issues had more to do with historical not matching 12 months ago. HAA used to make adjustments, but the financials we are seeing are what is actually reflected in quickbooks. Equity 219K, club is quite healthy. We are in the black this year. We don't have a lot of overhead associated with event mostly because of zoom. Vast majority of our expenditures are in Admin expenses. We are in the position where Admin will look more regular because we are paying actual instead of pre paying. Still investigating whether we are going to change bookkeeping. Looking a a variety of sources and being careful to look at bookkeeping separate from accounting. Trying to do recommendations by next meeting.

- Membership Committee Report (Zeng, Trotter, Halas)

Working on getting virtual presence strong to mine for membership. Looking at using incentives like Harvard Club of Chicago 150 year book. Numbers look pretty good to date. Did a sales pitch during welcome to your city. Targeting to the lists of attendees for these events. Trying to set this up before months end.

- Schools Committee Report (Palmer)

Very first likely letter admit in already. Female runner from Latin school and this is a bit early for us. Remember to fill our eligibility form for interviewing. Format changed to get an interview, This year we are doing interview invites through a link to help eliminate our outreach from getting lost.

Interview pool is expected to be about the same but will update as it grows. With deferrals, we haven't heard anything official about accommodating the 20% or so students who have deferred.

Being asked by high schoolers about contingency if pandemic lasts through 2021 through 2022. They may bring more than just seniors back to campus so we are keeping an eye on these decisions.

Harvard thinks that handling the pandemic is going pretty well. Admissions office is not requiring test scores for admissions this year.

- Community Service (Hochstadt)

Project for mentoring in cook county department of corrections is still in ongoing discussions. DD of education in dept is main contact. GED preparation is one opportunity. Non-site based assistance to assist inmates working on GED. We may piggyback on existing modules. Work on main topics that are necessary for the GED. We will remain virtual until it is safe for in person tutoring. We floated some ideas for practical learning read, write, financial literacy. Trying to launch next month before Thanksgiving. The current educators involved are very positive, so it appears it will be a useful and rewarding experience for the alumni who get involved. Open to local Harvard alum and affiliates. Going to run a description in the next newsletter. Inmates have to qualify for the program. May want to consider branching out into tutoring for Juvenile detention which the committee will do.

- Communications Committee Report (Ribaud, Minkoff)

Email to committee and they will get it into the newsletter.

- Club Administration (Bergen)

Working on the contract with Molly and should be signed soon. Delighted to have Molly on board. Looking at bookkeeping, Dec 2 meeting. Stuck with our current storage, Chuck to get keys from Bob. Working on finding the 25' banner.
